An engagement with God on the terms that He propose and in a way that He alone makes possible. ~David Peterson

Worship is the believer's response of all that they are – mind, emotions, will, body – to what God is and says and does. ~Warren Wiersbe

> Rather than asking, how <u>WAS</u> worship today, we should be asking, how <u>DID</u> I worship today.



b. In spirit.

> True worship is an inside out act; my spirit must be involved for worship to be authentic.

b. In truth.

Truth is the objective factor in worship and spirit is the subjective. Both must come together. ... The worship that occurred on Mount Gerizim was enthusiastic heresy. The worship offered at Jerusalem was barren lifeless orthodoxy. Jerusalem had truth but not spirit. Gerizim had the spirit but not truth. ... Sincerity, enthusiasm, and aggressiveness are important, but they must be based on truth. And truth is foundational, but if it doesn't result in an eager, excited, enthusiastic heart, it is deficient. ~John MacArthur
