The texts indicate a wide variety of instruments, similar to our modern harps, trumpets, flutes, percussion, and guitars. To those who object to the use of guitars and drums in worship, I would comment that the instruments mentioned in the psalm headings look more like modern guitars and percussion than modern pianos and organs. ... God's praise also included, as we have seen, dance and clapping. Some texts urge us to praise God with a loud noise or "shout" ... or with "resounding cymbals" ... From these data, and from the instruments mentioned above, I would conclude that the ancient music was often strongly rhythmic and loud. I would not be surprised if some of it would sound rather raucous. ~John Frame
