A. By justifying us. Galatians 3:24

➤ Justified. I stand before God guilty and condemned but He declares me righteous.

Justification is a word that simply means that our record is both “just as if we had never sinned” and also “just as if we had always obeyed.” ~Elyse Fitzpatrick, Give Them Grace, page 46



B. By redeeming us. Luke 1:68, Galatians 4:4-5

➤ Redeemed. I stand before God as a slave, but He sets me free.

C. By forgiving us. Ephesians 1:7-8, Colossians 2:13-14

➤ Forgiven. I stand before God as guilty debtor, but He pays my debt and forgets it.

Jesus drinks the cup of God's wrath, a cup that has accumulated the fury of God against sins of all types. Heinous crimes, adultery, careless words, dishonoring thoughts, lies – all of it will be punished by God. D. By adopting us. Galatians 4:4-5

➤ Adopted. I stand before God as a stranger, but He makes me His son.

E. By reconciling us. Ephesians 2:13, Colossians 1:21

➤ Reconcile. I stand before God as an enemy, but He makes me a friend.

Reconciliation teaches something remarkable about the character of God: he befriends his enemies. He loves those who hate him. He offers peace to those who have waged war against him. Although he is the one who has been wronged, he is the one who makes things right.
